PRAY WITHOUT CEASING U.S. CHURCHES

Creekside Community Church – McMinnville, OR

- Praise God we were able to continue meeting as a body on Sundays and in Missional Communities throughout COVID without interruption.

- Praise God for the development of a well-rounded and healthy staff: Brought on Hannah Reid for Admin over the summer and Eric Loyer came on staff in October.

- Pray for a renewed sense of mission resulting in disciples made and churches planted (Acts 2:47).

- God, in His providence, has already brought 3-4 Crossway families to the church as we re-plant Living Water. This will provide the beginnings of a planting team to energize and establish this new work in Christ.

- Pray for wisdom and discernment on how to supportively care for as well as encourage the existing congregation to make new disciples and live on mission.
- Pray for the upcoming camps and outreach happening June 21st-25th with a team of interns from Chicago led by Matt Scott. Pray for divine encounters and for connections with at least three families.
- Pray for more families and leaders to be sent to join us who have a heart for mission and outreach in the unique Hispanic culture of East Greeley.
